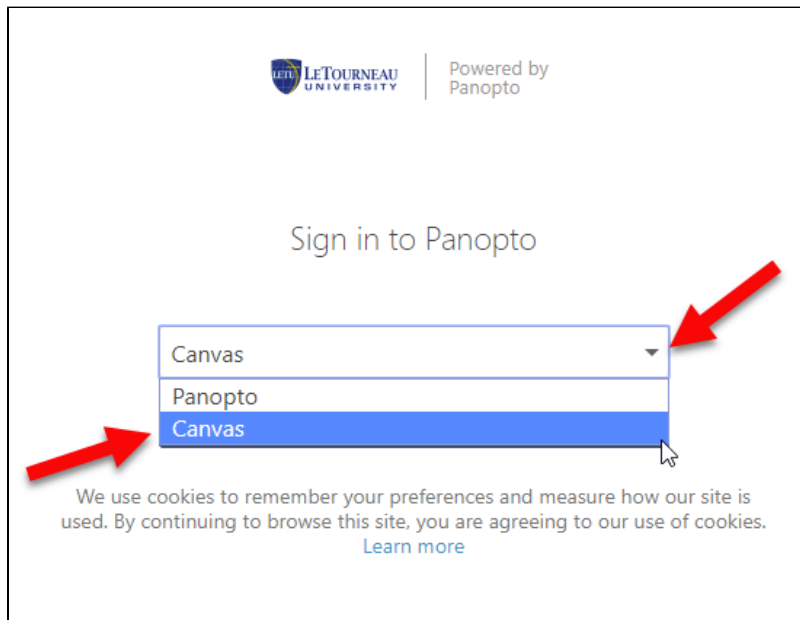
## Panopto Recorder
